Admission Requirements

Small Sizes Only

To ensure the comfort and safety of all our furry guests, we currently cater specifically to small and smaller medium-sized dogs.

Why Small

Our facilities and services are specially designed to meet the unique needs of smaller breeds.

- This focus allows us to maintain a high standard of care and personalized attention for each pet.

What is a Small size?

- Small Dogs: Typically weighing up 10 kg.



Flea & Worm Treatment

Please ensure your pet regularly has flea and tick treatment as well as deworming treatment.

All dogs must also have a name tag with owner contact details.

Assessment & temperament requirements

All dogs staying with us will be screened to determine their temperament and social behaviours. Only dogs that are properly socialized and do not display aggressive tendencies will be accepted in the Daycare.

We can't have females on heat in the Day Care.

Vaccinations

All dogs attending Pawlina day care needs to be updated with the necessary vaccinations needed. (L4 - Leptospirosis, DHP - Distemper, Infectious Hepatitis and Parvo)



Walks

- Before your dog can join group walks with other dogs, we will conduct an initial individual walk to assess their behaviour and reactions. This helps us ensure the safety and enjoyment of all dogs in our care.
- Your dog will need to have basic training such as recall.
NB: If your dog is not leash trained they will only be doing short walks around the neighbourhood for safety reasons and we might ask you to do leash training.

Puppies

- No pups under 12 months



Regular Weekly Client Policy

Minimum 1 days per week of Day-Care

At Pawlina, we prioritize the well-being of all dogs. To ensure a stable and comfortable environment, we encourage regular attendance.

Scheduling:

- Choose fixed or flexible days each week for your dog's attendance. We prefer fixed days (Flexible days are never guaranteed)

This policy helps create a nurturing environment where dogs feel like part of the Pawlina family and get used to a routine.

Benefits:

- Regular attendance helps your dog build strong bonds and feel more secure.
- A consistent pack reduces anxiety and promotes a safer, more enjoyable experience.
